ADDRESSING THE REAL NEEDS OF WOMEN

Abortion is an invasive and humiliating procedure; an affront to human dignity. It is always a personal tragedy and a sign that society has greatly failed women.

No woman should be forced to choose between the life of her child and her educational or career plans. In a society that is truly concerned about her needs, both options should be fully accessible to her.

Thus, it is of extreme importance that we educate both the public and our policy-making government representatives who use tax dollars to fund abortion.

RESEARCH

Our research facilities house information for use by students, educators, the media and the general public. We sponsor billboards, newspaper ads and other media events. Our volunteers interact directly with the public in our annual Street Educational Campaigns.
